TREK LIMITED WARRANTY. UNDERCARRIAGE

Trek warranty covers only new parts sold by Trek Inc, which are correctly installed and used in a normal operation.

Coverage is limited to the first 4000 hours of service or three years from purchase or 100% worn, whichever comes first.

Adjustment is determined pro-rata based on the measurement of key components or ratio of service life received. Pro-rata value is at TREK's determination.

Adjustments for premature dry joints in oil lubricated chain is limited to the failed parts replaced.

Tracks with wide shoes have the normal warranty adjustment reduced by 50%.

Crawler skidder, forestry applications and other non-traditional use equipment have the normal warranty adjustment reduced by 50%.

Excavator track link assemblies that are seized due to periods of inactivity in high moisture environments are not considered as product defects and therefore not eligible for warranty.

Product coverage is for:

- Components and assemblies of crawler rollers, idlers, sprockets, chain, shoes and fasteners.
- Seal leakage in SALT chains, rollers and idlers groups.
- Abnormal breakage of components.

TREK LIMITED WARRANTY. NON-UNDERCARRIAGE

Trek warranty covers only new parts sold by Trek, Inc. which are correctly installed and used in a normal operation. Engine components are covered by the manufacturer's warranty.

Coverage is limited to the first 1200 hours of service or six months from purchase date, whichever comes first.

Our adjustment is limited to the replacement of or merchandise credit

for, the failed Trek supplied part. No additional items may be applied. Nondefective items are not subject to warranty and may not be returned as warranty.

Labor, freight, travel and other costs related to a part failure are not covered by this warranty.

Product coverage is for:

- Parts or assemblies which fail to perform correctly.
- Leaking sealed assemblies.
- Abnormal breakage

No other warranty is expressed or implied, as to quality, performance, freedom of defect, merchantability or fitness.

TREK LIMITED WARRANTY. RUBBER TRACK

Trek warranty covers only new rubber track sold by Trek, Inc. which are correctly installed and used in a normal operation.

Coverage is limited to the first 20 months of service from invoice date. There is no adjustment for hours within the warranty period.

Warranty excludes labor, transportation, and improperly installed track.
Improperly used and normal wear and tear as determined by Trek
Inc. Technical Department.

All product claims for warranty must be submitted with invoice documentation, photos of the product code and defect being claimed. Products claimed under warranty do not need to be returned unless specified by Trek Technical Department for inspection.
